ASSIGNMENT INFORMATION:

Write a short journal entry (250 words minimum, 1500 words maximum) describing what you thought about the content provided during this week's lecture, reading assignments, and in-class discussions. You can write about the content that you liked, what you did not like, how the content does or does not apply to your artistic practice, or the connections you made between the course content and video games, art pieces, or events you have played or seen. Feel free to include images, links to videos, or references to other written works as needed.

The purpose of this weekly reflection is to think critically about the content you just learned. This weekly reflection is freeform, so one week you may elaborate on how you liked the course content and how it greatly relates to your artistic practice, but the next week you elaborate on how you disliked the course and how it does not relate to your artistic practice at all.
