## ASSIGNMENT INFORMATION:

To begin your game design journey, you will take elements that you learned in class to begin planning a video game or interactive new media art instillation concept pitch.

For the final video game concept pitch, you will be providing visual references, narrative elements, and game play mechanics and explain the average player experience of the game.

You have the choice of coming up with a original concept, taking an existing intellectual property (IP) and propose a sequel, or coming up with an interactive new media art instillation.

(NOTE: If you choose a pre-existing IP, you MUST incorporate new game mechanics and story not found in the original game.

If you choose an interactive new media art instillation, the instillation must include graphic visuals and a controller/device of some sort to allow for player interaction)

For next class, do the following:

- Establish which type of concept you are pitching:
  - original concept, continuation of a pre-existing IP, or an interactive new media art instillation.
- Fill out the Game Design Document for at least **two different concepts**
- Include visual references of pre-existing games/art works
- Include narrative references of pre-existing games/art works
